<u>Solos: The Jazz Sessions - Matthew Shipp</u> Tuesday, September 1st 7:00pm KGP

With his unique and recognizable style, pianist Matthew Shipp worked and recorded vigorously during the 1990s, creating music in which free jazz and modern classical intertwine. Through his range of live and recorded performances, and unswerving individual development, Shipp came to be regarded as a prolific and respected voice in creative music by the decade's close.

The Merry Widow (German: Die lustige Witwe) is an operetta by the Austro-Hungarian composer Franz Lehár. The librettists, Viktor Léon and Leo Stein, based the story – concerning a rich widow, and her countrymen's attempt to keep her money in the principality by finding her the right husband – on an 1861 comedy play, L'attaché d'ambassade (The Embassy Attaché) by Henri Meilhac.

<u>Muddy Waters Blues Band - Live at Rockpalast</u> Tuesday, September 8th 7:00pm KGP

At Westfalenhalle Dortmund on December 10, 1978 for the Rockpalast recording Muddy Waters mighty vocals and his splendid charisma on stage fascinated the audience. Muddy's guitar playing on the Fender Telecaster comes into full effect with his slow blues solos – and seldom had Muddy such a hot sound.

<u>Rigoletto - Verdi</u> Thursday, September 10th 1:00pm KGP

Michael Mayer's acclaimed production, first seen in the 2012–13 season, sets the action of Verdi's masterpiece in 1960 Las Vegas – a neon-lit world ruled by money and ruthless, powerful men. Piotr Beczala is the Duke, a popular entertainer and casino owner who will stop at nothing to get what he wants. Zeljko Lucic sings Rigoletto, his sidekick, and comedian, and Diana Damrau is Rigoletto's innocent daughter, Gilda. When she is seduced by the Duke, Rigoletto sets out on a tragic course of murderous revenge. Stefan Kocan is the assassin Sparafucile and Michele Mariotti conducts.


